Dear Parents

It was good to see so many of you at Monday's "Meet the Teacher". Thank you again for the support we have received over the last few months. Following our meeting, the PTA AGM took place and it was not possible to fill all the roles identified in the Constitution.

This is such an essential part of the life of the school; the partnership between parents and staff, the opportunities the PTA create that go over and beyond the capacity of current school budgets and the social aspects of the PTA both adults and for the children. Harrison (15th) was first Year 6 boy followed by Willis (32nd), Joseph (33rd), William (43rd) and Billy (92nd). Unfortunately, Sidhart was knocked over at the first corner and unable to finish.

Jake picked up a medal for 4rd in the Year 5 boys race and the team was made up of Nana Kwame (24th), Alex (91st) and James (108th), while Annabel P(36th) was the leading Year 6 girl, followed by Annabel W (69th), Grace (91st), Evie (92nd) and Florence (104th), who ran despite a foot injury.
