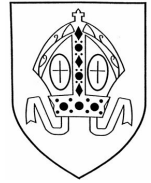

Dear Parents

A very busy week for all departments of the school this week! The children have applied themselves well; it was a pleasure to hear the Year 3 children were commended for their excellent behaviour in The Cathedral on their Advent day.

The thirty-six children who took part in the Barnardo's Concert in Southwark Cathedral on Wednesday sang beautifully in that acoustic. Mrs Kenna attended the concert to hear the children sing "Prepare for the Lord" by Mr Kenna; a special moment. Thanks are due to Mrs Miller for training and conducting the choir, our excellent Flautist, Emily, an ex-pupil, Mrs Wilkins and the parents who came to help, in what was a very long day.

You will appreciate that attendance and lateness is monitored closely by the school and at various points of the year we identify some slippage.

Whilst responding to the pressures of the Riverside build, we are usually managing to open the gates earlier. We are aware it takes time for pupils and parents to come in through the two narrow gates and equally leave. However, there are a number of pupils who are consistently arriving to the playground gates after the bell to the playground. This is damaging for the children in terms of the early morning work they miss or are late starting, the social and emotional impact and the delay to the staff being able to undertake their other roles. We would ask that you review your morning routines to support the children achieving punctuality; an important life skill. Please also ensure you are parking in a safe place.

Finally, a huge thank you to the PTA team led by Lucy Steel and supported by Charlotte Laurence who provided an excellent Christmas Bazaar last Saturday. The family commitment, whether manning stalls, or spending at them, the high attendance of all community members, parents, staff, ex-pupil and parents (and of course Father Christmas!) produced a highly successful event with both a fantastic atmosphere and a great outcome.
