**Dear Parents**

Thanks are due to Mrs Miller for training and conducting the choir, our excellent Flautist, Emily, an ex-pupil, Mrs Wilkins and the parents who came to help, in what was a very long day.

You will appreciate that attendance and lateness is monitored closely by the school and at various points of the year we identify some slippage.

Whilst responding to the pressures of the Riverside build, we are usually managing to open the gates earlier. 
