Please can we request that parents do not use the last few years SATs papers for home study or tutor use for year 6 revision because this is a resource hugely valued within school and any previous experience the children have of these papers cause the assessment data to then be incorrect and not useful to target particular areas of learning.



There is now an online booking system for instrumental lessons which can be accessed following the link on the school website (go to Our School and then Music at the Cathedral School). Once you have signed your child up his/her name will appear on a waiting list and stay there until one of our tutors has space. Children can begin Piano, Violin and Guitar lessons from Year 2, Woodwind and Brass from Year 3 dependent sometimes on the development of their adult teeth but they can be signed up before that. It is a good idea to sign your child up so that he/she is on the list when a place becomes available; there will be spaces on all instruments from September. You can sign your child up for more than one instrument and signing up does not oblige you to take up a place.

#### Prospective Student Tours – Spring Term 2019
