Plans are well underway for the innovation of our "Party in the Playground" next Friday.


This is intended to be a whole school celebration of the year, a relaxing and fun few hours with supper and some entertainment provided to make a good start to the week-end for pupils and adults alike.


BASKETBALL DISTRICT FINAL
