

Dear Parents,

What an exciting week it's been this week! It started with the Year 6 production; "What a Knight" at Chelmsford County High School for Girls on Monday where the children's talent was showcased and supported by a whole team led by the Mrs Miller and Mrs Prentice. It was brilliant!

Tuesday saw the successful appointment of a new teacher for Class 3 in September who will meet the children on our transition afternoon next Monday. Mrs Prentice took the children to "Schools Gotta Dance" that night, where they were fantastic and it was lovely to have Mrs Dougall there who started this process off before taking on new challenges in life. Proving, yet again, that no one ever really leaves The Cathedral School.

Whilst this took place the Trust and Governors had meetings that evening. In the morning the Key Stage 2 results came out nationally and together with our EYFS, phonics and KS1 outcomes reflecting the great success of the pupils, their teachers and the partnership we have with parents!

The pace continues to the steadily approaching end of term on 24th July.

SNACKS



Please note that if your child is bringing in a snack from home for morning break that this needs to be fresh fruit, dried fruit or vegetables. Nut Free School

A reminder that we are a nut-free school. We appreciate that this may seem extreme, but the only way we can protect children with severe nut allergies, of whom we have several is to be complete in this approach. We understand that this may be frustrating for parents who have not experienced this, but we will not take risks with any child's health. We do not allow nuts or nut products in school lunch boxes or in theirs snacks. This will also include Chocolate Spread and Pesto because many contain nut products. Thank you for co-operation.

HAIR

Long/Shoulder length hair should be tied back at all times for health and safety reasons. We would also suggest that your child's hair is checked regularly for head lice and treated, if necessary, before attending school. We ask that hair styles should be 'standard' and that the more exciting styles be left to the summer holiday.

It is part of the ethos of the school that the personality of the children should shine through and extreme hairstyles such as tramlines, unnatural colours and streaks are distractions and not acceptable. For health and safety reasons shoulder length hair must be tied back at all times
