Summer Holiday Courses at Redbridge Cycling Centre

Novice Go-ride Skills

Fun skills in our coaching area for ages 5-10 concentrating on basic cycling techniques (must be able to ride without stabilisers).

Intermediate Go-ride Skills

Basic skills development in the coaching area and on the circuit for riders who have completed the Novice Go-ride skills course.

Ages 5-10

Advanced Go-ride Skills

Further skills development before progressing to discipline specific courses for riders who have completed the Intermediate Go-ride courses. Ages 8+

Introduction to Mountain biking

Suitable for riders who have limited off road experience.

Ages 8-14

Mountain Biking Follow Up

Suitable for riders who have completed the introduction course or riders wishing to improve their skills. Ages 8-14

Introduction to Road Racing

Course for riders who are competent and would like to try road racing bikes. Road bikes can be hired from the Centre.

Ages 8-14

Road Racing Follow Up

Further road racing skills for riders who have completed the introduction course and would like to get into racing. Ages 8-14.

Introduction to BMX

Suitable for competent cyclists who wish to try BMX, this course is an introduction to techniques needed to ride the BMX track safely. Riders must be able to cycle standing up.

BMX Follow Up

Suitable for riders who have completed the introduction to BMX course or riders who have basic BMX skills, this course will concentrate on improving skills and preparing to race.

All sessions cost £12.50 per child. Bikes are available to hire for an extra £5.00. Courses start promptly so please ensure that children are signed in 15 minutes before the start.

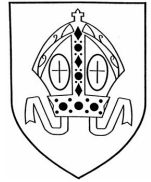
