If you are able to spare any time to help with this move, we expect to start the actual move from Wednesday next week. Please let the office know.


The weather is reported to be good this weekend.

Year 3 Children and Universal Free School Meals

If you have a child in Year 3 they will have been receiving Free School Meals in the past couple of years alongside all other KS1 children. The cost of school meals is £2.30 per day and payment is preferred via SCOPay where there is a minimum payment of £11.50. 
