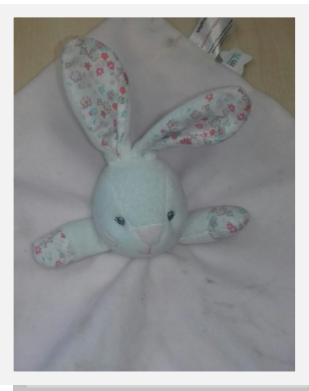
Charlotte (Class 7), "The flash paper trick was really interesting as they revealed film makers secrets. They showed us how cool and amazing science is!"
