Dear Parents,

This week sees the end of the Key Stage 2 Statutory Assessment Tests. We are very pleased with the way the children approached and completed the tests and congratulate them on passing this milestone. Results will not arrive until the end of the first week in July when they will be passed on as quickly as possible. In the meantime, Year 6 can return to the joy of learning a vast variety of ways with a School Journey on the horizon and the excitement of the transition programmes the Secondary Schools put in place next half term.

In Class Council meetings this week, all classes have been responding to a survey by the Chelmsford Teaching School Alliance, so that our representatives can take their views to a major Young Person's Conference we are involved in at Hylands House in June. They have been considering how they can make a difference. This includes their aspirations educationally, now and in the long term, and caring for the environment, both locally and on a national and global scale.

Next week details will be issued about the first of our Classroom visits offered to parents in the following half term. Staff think that moving on from our parental workshops; it would be valuable for parents to see how children learn in class. We will be offering the opportunity to sign up to be in a lesson and catch up on how we teach a subject, in this case mathematics. It is not easy to manage additional adults in a limited space and of course, it must not be disruptive to your children, so places will be limited to three per class and parents will not visit a lesson in their child's class. However, having done this before I know it was a useful experience for all concerned. We will issue the date/dates for this term next week with an agreed protocol and you will be able to book a slot. We appreciate this will be for limited numbers, but we would hope that parents find this helpful and we are able to continue this process in coming terms and provide the opportunity for different parents to come each time.


