## SUMMER CONCERT

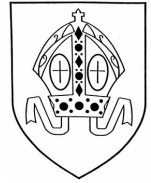
On Wednesday evening our children had the opportunity to showcase their musical talents at our Summer concert. Another chance for our pupils to shine.

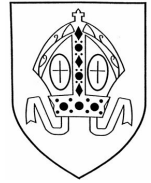
