

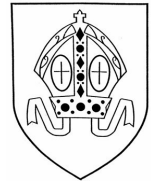

The next Year 6 Isle of Wight instalment of £80 is due by today (28th February 2020). Prompt payment will be greatly appreciated.

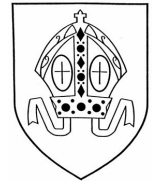
