Head Teacher's Message

Dear Parents,

If you have not yet seen my letter about a confirmed case of COVID-19, I would ask you to check your emails as I discovered my letter to staff had automatically gone into a junk folder. Like COVID-19, it can happen in the best regulated circles.

Firstly, our thoughts and prayers are with the member of the community who has a confirmed case and then with those few who are now isolating for safety.

Secondly, I appreciate the concern caused when this happens; with the increased anxiety as Essex moved to Tier 2, education settings open and the pressures to sustain some sort of normal life it is perfectly reasonable to feel like that. There is no doubt that our faith and resilience will continue to be tested over the coming months.

Times like this cause great speculation and everyone wants to know "who" and assess the risk, which of course is not possible under data protection. All I can say at this point is that we have followed all correct procedures since the beginning of the pandemic and minimized the risk.
