Head Teacher's Message

Dear Parents,

The whole school undertook the Act of Remembrance this week, albeit in their separate classrooms, led by our Worship group. With all the windows open, the effect of the canon firing rang through the school along with the Last Post and The Reveille and there was solemn and thoughtful response from the children as they respected the sacrifice of those who have died in conflicts.

As the "normality" of school continues, we continue to make adjustments to try and maximise our learning time in school, whilst it is important to have a care for the well-being of the staff, who are providing longer hours and increased teaching time within the school day with reduced breaks, lunchtimes and in the time gained around worship. It is also clear that good use is being made of time distributed fairly as we all work smarter to "close the gap".

Next week we see the change to our start time as we move from 8.30 to 8.40 am and come in in five minute intervals. This decision was made to balance the children's learning time and achieve greater equality. Once it was clear that the children who had more time at the end of the day were struggling to benefit from the time, we looked for ways of achieving that time more effectively within the school day. The other reason was to achieve safety through the staggering of arrivals and departures and reduce the possibility of social contact. To alleviate the pressure outside the school, Christie (Blue) will be invited in to line up socially distanced outside the classroom prior to the 8.40am and 3pm bell.

Please note there are workshops available for parents for RSE (Relationship and Sex Education) which you may find helpful before we reach our consultation period for our new policy in 2021. (see page 4)

With Remembrance this week, thoughts begin to turn towards Christmas in the last 5 weeks of term.

Christmas will be celebrated in school with activities planned including crafts, and a form of Christmas performance. We are having a Christmas jumper day for charity, but essentially at the heart of Christmas is about the gift of Jesus to the world and we are looking at giving.

Our main event is being led by Miss Southward who writes "This year we are unable to go and sing as usual at the local care homes in Chelmsford. However, we greatly value our links with them. In order to maintain our connections, we are planning to produce books of letters, puzzles, pictures, messages and poems from the children to share with the residents both to assure them of our thoughts and prayers and to help our children think of others at this Christmas time. These will be produced in class, quarantined, then distributed safely"

We will be giving Christmas cards this year with a system to ensure safety by quarantining as well. I mention this early to provide preparation time.
