Head Teacher's Message

Dear Parents,

I have enjoyed observing and teaching this week and it is pleasing to see how well learning is happening and how well children in KS2 cope when sitting in lines that limit teaching styles and methods. Teachers are aware of the limitations and every effort is being made to make sure learning is stimulating and proactive.

Parents Consultations

As I write this week, we are half way through our Parent Consultations and most parents in EYFS and KS1 were able to join their child's teacher/teachers with the minimum of delay. Where it has not been possible, alternative communication is being supplied. We look forward to KS2 consultations next week for which appointments have been allocated. When each phases ends their consultation period, then there is an online survey to complete. The school leadership always finds this very helpful; all feedback is appreciated especially as we have had to reorganise the school to meet safety and learning needs.

Entrance and exits

Thank you to everyone for the response to the adjustment in the start and end times. As we get closer to our normal start and end times, I am conscious this is challenging when trying to meet the changed arrangements of other schools and work arrangements. This week saw work being done on a local home that added to the impact of the narrow path on our side of the road in Victoria Rd. Whist the issues on Victoria Rd are tackled via Essex Highways alternative improvements are being explored including the possibility of creating another gate that would provide access on Waterloo Lane and avoid the drive and front of the school currently being used for leaving the site on the one way system. In the long term this would also support CASP collections and when they resume, collection from afterschool activities.

Key questions coming up.

Yes we are facilitating **Christmas** cards and Teachers are preparing their gifts for their classes. I will send out how we will achieve this, because it involves quarantining anything going to and from home. More DFE Guidance will come for December but Christmas dinners and Christmas celebrations are planned with an increased degree of safety to ensure that the children experience as many of the usual joys of the season, or alternatives to our usual festivities. Details will come out next week.
