Head Teacher's Message

Dear Parents,

Thank you to everyone who has met with the teachers for Parent Consultations, the second half; Key Stage 2 have taken part this week. The final rearrangements have been made or are being set up for any parent who have contacted their teacher. It's very helpful to have feedback and if you haven't yet finished the survey please do so. It has been very reassuring for us as a staff team to be working together and for our work, commitment and flexibility to be recognised by you.

Today saw the first Full Governing Body meeting with our new parent Governors when new monitoring roles were allocated and taken up. We are looking forward to the coming months when Governors will be actually able to enter the school, but in the meantime, adaption of practice is in place to complete governance and accountability.

The commitment of the PTA during these difficult times for fundraising has meant that the final interactive whiteboard is now in place in Early Years.

Our new set of laptops bought with our external funding are eagerly awaited, when there is availability; unsurprisingly there is a major shortage at the moment.

What will Christmas look like this year?

- 1. The children have been preparing boxes of messages and ideas and games to take to the local senior citizen homes who usually enjoy our singing.
- 2. The "Save the Children" Christmas jumper day will happen on **Friday 11**th **December**. Mrs Grover has written with details of that on page 4.
- 3. We are determined to sing and to share the message of joy and hope this season so there will be open air singing around our outside Christmas tree and Christmas lights for the community. We have received a Christmas tree from Larkins Farm.
- 4. Christmas cards: each class will have its own post box and cards may be brought into each class for class members to go in the post box from Monday 30th. They will be distributed on Monday 7th after quarantine. Cards may then come in from Tuesday 8th until Friday 11th. These cards will be distributed in the last week. All cards for outside the class bubbles, can be posted in the office post box. For both boxes, the last day for Christmas post is 11th December!
- 5. Christmas dinners: EYFS and KS1 will have their Christmas dinner on Tuesday 8th

 December, other year groups will have a packed lunch in class. These can be supplied by school if your child normally has a dinner. A separate order form will go out. Middle and Upper phases will have their dinner on Wednesday 9th December and the other years will eat a packed lunch in class. Apologies that we will not be able to offer a hot alternative to the other half of the school on each of those days, but this makes it possible for the children to have the Christmas dinner experience.
- 6. **EYFS Nativity and KS1 Production**: this will be put together safety and recorded to be available to the other pupils and parents in that phase. It will be available in the last week
- 7. There will also be an internal Carol Service
- 8. **Christmas parties**: on the last day of term, **18**th **December**, we are planning Class Bubble Christmas parties and we are expecting a visit from Father Christmas.

Details of each event will come out on the calendar and by separate Scopay emails to ensure clarity. In the meantime I wish everyone a safe and happy weekend
