Firstly, it has been amazing to see so much fantastic learning and great engagement occurring through the live Teams sessions this week. I have had the privilege of being part of them as Deputy Head and home-schooling my own daughter 2 days a week. We truly understand how hard it can be. With this in mind, we would encourage you to attend as many 'live' sessions as you can. If completing the work is too much, please try not to worry. Going forward we ask:

- 1. Upload one tapestry post with all of the learning for that day as a maximum. That way, staff can look at all of the days learning in one go.
- 2. When using the chat function on Teams, please ensure it is only for answering questions the teacher has asked and posing possible problems (this is more specific to Year 5 and 6 who do like a chat!)
- 3. 'Catch up' social. The timetable for live sessions remains unchanged. Each year group will however have a shortened Foundation input on one afternoon to allow for the children to have a catch up / chat/ play some games with each other, ensuring their social and emotional needs are also being met.
- 4. You may post observations and questions on Tapestry at any time that is convenient to you but to ensure we are also trying to meet the wellbeing of our staff, they are asked to check Tapestry between 8:45-5pm so if you post outside of those hours, you may not get a response until the next day.

Thank you all for your continued support. It has been such a pleasure to see both our school based children and home based children participating in learning with such enthusiasm on the same learning, wherever that learning may be base, ensuring consistency for all.
