Head Teacher's Message

Dear Parents and Carers

It was such good news to hear this week that all the children will return to school on Monday 8th March. If rules are followed across the country and transmissions rates, continue to go down as successful vaccinations increase we will be able to look forward to the lifting of other restrictions as the months go by.

The return to school should be quite straightforward with us reverting to what we did from September to Christmas with a few adjustments. Of course, when I said this to the staff, everyone looked vaguely blank; as I am not sure, anyone can remember what that version of school life actually was!

We will continue to be in class bubbles within our phase Bubbles: EYFS, KS1 (Years 1 and 2) Middle school (Years 3 and 4), Upper school (Years 5 and 6.)

We will have staggered starts, playtimes, lunchtimes and leaving times. We are not able to meet as a whole school in the hall as we cannot mix Bubbles yet. Books and paper work continue to be isolated and children need to come into school in their PE kits on PE days. Breakfast Club and CASP continue, but other extra-curricular activities are expected to resume at a point until after Easter.

Most staff members have not yet been called for vaccination and we proceed with caution. There are two major differences to when we were last in school:

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
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In preparation for World Book Day, on Thursday 4th March, please may you keep hold of an egg box or two; there will be a project for your child to complete!


