

No latex balloons are released. This is a virtual race where you can track the balloons on their simulated journey. It's all the fun with the added bonus of being environmentally friendly. The Easter Race virtual balloons are released at The Wailing Wall, Jerusalem

Buy and customise your balloon any time before the race. Your virtual balloon will be released at noon, 4 April and the race can be tracked as if it was a real balloon. At the end of the race the balloon that travels the furthest gets a prize!



Once purchased you can then go in and customise your balloon to your desired specifications



£500 cash, Apple iPad, 10 x £10 book tokens In addition, the Cathedral School balloon that travels the furthest will win a £20 fifty gift voucher!!



Balloons are subject to a simulated flight pattern based on your balloon's individual flight parameters plus the real weather conditions at that actual time such as the prevailing wind speed and current temperature. This simulation uses an advanced computer modelling programme linked to a mapping provider and Aeris, a commercial global weather data supplier.


