'Thy Kingdom come' prayer space in Guy Harlings garden

It's been great to welcome each class in the school to take part in prayer activities during this time between Ascension Day and Pentecost. We've experienced sun, wind and rain, but it's been a joy to be outside in the peaceful, green space of Guy Harlings garden. I've spotted several children with their arms outstretched and one girl voiced that she felt free.





Prayer is all about engaging with and communicating with God, and although it often involves words, it doesn't have to and our garden prayer stations involved creating, drawing, looking closely or some kind of action, as well as opportunities to listen and write.

All ages enjoyed the bubble machine – watching bubbles burst reminded us of the forgiveness and new start God gives us, and tying ribbons onto a big cross

was a way of bringing our thoughts and feelings to Jesus. We collected things from around the garden and looked at our faces in mirrors, praising God for the way he has made everything — and everyone so wonderfully. We put tea-lights on a map of Chelmsford and prayed for our city, and stuck post-it note prayers on a large map of the word. Making pipe-cleaner people (and some animals too!) was popular and encouraged us to pray for our families and friends. We wrote down or drew on hand-shapes things and people we are thankful for, and





thought about what we mean when we pray, 'Your Kingdom come'. Each class also made a beautiful prayer wall of prayers to take back to their classrooms.

After such a strange year or so, it's been a special way of re-connecting with each class. I hope we can do it again sometime.
