Dear All,

Our theme this week has been "Harvest" led by our Chaplain Jean in the school hall on Monday, when she built a shelter with the children to celebrate Sukkot, or the Feast of the Tabernacles. Worship and RE are strongly linked in our themes this year, providing opportunities for greater understanding and follow up in class.
