#### **Cross Country**

Cross-country competition returned to the calendar after a two-year gap last week with Cathedral pupils achieving personal bests and claiming three medals across the four races at Melbourne Stadium.

On a 1,200m course, which started with a lap of the track, taking in the surrounding grass and mounds before returning to finish next to the main straight, the Year 6 girls started proceedings and claimed a creditable third place in the team race with 57 points. Sienna finished fifth followed by Ellie (11th), Maisie (16th), Sophie (25th), Francine (31st), Mimi (50th) and Isabella (59th). In the Year 6 boys race, there was a third-place finish for Oscar while Jake, Neel, Teddy, George, Zachary and Oliver ensured the team came fifth overall.

The afternoon continued with a ninth place for our Year 5 girls lead home by Akosua (12th) and Ffion (21st) with Emily, Sonia and Aliza completing the scoring. Finally, the Year 5 boys secured fourth place overall and another medal with Seb taking 3rd, followed by Henry, Ethan (31st), Max (37th), Cornelius (40th), Timmie (43rd) and Samson (77th).









#### Netball


On Monday, we hosted our first netball match since 2019 against Our Lady Immaculate.



#### Does this apply to your family?

- Is your child providing practical, physical, emotional or personal care for a family member?
- Is your child helping to look after someone in the family home who is ill, physically or mentally disabled, have a learning difficulty or misuse drugs or alcohol?
- Does your child do more than their peers? For example: cooking, housework, helping someone out of bed or looking after brothers and sisters.

As a result of this extra responsibility your child might be suffering from anxiety, loneliness, lack of sleep, friendship problems, be late or miss school.
