Head Teacher's Message

Dear All,

Happy New Year to all!

Welcome to Mr Mower, joining us in Class 7. Mrs Quinn will continue her teaching commitment in Class 7.

The New Year brings additional challenges as Covid and the new variant goes through communities. We are continuing the measures we had in place relating to hygiene and distancing. This involves attempting to create more distance between phases.

We returned to school with two staff absences and 3.15% pupil absence with Covid. This is our starting point, but as soon as we are together again, inevitably those who contracted the virus at the end of the holiday will see a positive test emerge and numbers will go up. A class received a letter today.

As the protocol has changed, I can only urge you and your children to take lateral flow tests regularly in order to monitor health and protect the community. This is proving difficult of course whilst there is a huge demand for tests, but please persist.

Work will be identified for pupils isolating with Covid who are not unwell or who are asymptomatic.

Where parents are in isolation but the children's tests are negative, prior arrangements can be made to drop off.

Our priority is to maintain education within the school and the school open as we are inevitably hit by staff and pupil illness. This may mean that staff move around to teach or support staff lead the learning under teacher direction. We will attempt to keep disruption to a minimum but I need to flag now that it will not be possible for staff to cover extracurricular activities after school for their colleagues.

Finally, as per the letter last term, the Riverside car park was closed today ready to be a compound for the vehicles involved in the work in Tindall Square. The Council are providing traffic wardens and support for the situation including providing a safe walk way past the compound for children(and adults) walking to and from school.

Please remember you will need to adjust your parking habits and should park in a car park further away and walk. This could signal an improvement for our safety outside school; we will monitor the situation carefully as we are in contact with the Council about this.


