


Nut Free School The school aims to protect children who have allergies to nuts, We do not allow nuts or nut products in school lunch boxes or in theirs snacks.

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
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Isolation Guidance

Day 0 of the isolation period is when you first show symptoms or, if asymptomatic, the day you took your test.

People self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative on both day 5 and day 6 (taken 24 hours apart) and do not have a temperature.

Individuals who are still positive on their rapid lateral flow tests must stay in isolation until they have had 2 consecutive negative tests taken on separate days or after day 10 isolation ends -no test required.


