Mrs Truelove will also be available for pre-booked appointments.

When the appointment ends, if you have another one for another child in the family, please return to the school corridor, leaving the books with the teacher and go to the next class. If your appointment has ended you will be able to leave by the hall door to the outside. In this way we are attempting a one-way system!


