

Message from School Crossing Patrol Service



Safety Message from the School Crossing Patrol Service

Could I please enlist your help with the following to improve safety at the Victoria Road school crossing site.

Patrols are trained to give equal consideration to pedestrians and drivers and try to gather small groups of pedestrians together before stopping traffic. Patrols also look for natural gaps in the traffic when possible to reduce the amount of disruption to traffic passing school crossing patrol sites. Please be patient and do not take the decision to cross yourself at the crossing site as other waiting children may follow you out into the road. During very busy times, the patrols may ask you to stop crossing and wait on the pavement whilst they exit the road to allow some traffic to pass.

Please do not allow children to run ahead of you to the crossing site. Due to the hoarding around the car park, when children emerge unaccompanied from the path onto Victoria Road, the patrols are unable to see whether the parents are in close proximity and patrols are then unnecessarily distracted to ensure the children do not move towards the roadside. Please keep children with you when approaching the main road and arrive at the crossing site together ready to cross the road. Thank you.

Please walk up to the crossing site tactile paving before you step off the pavement as when pedestrians cross the road diagonally from either the pavement near the school path or from the corner near the car park, this results in one of the patrols being unaware of pedestrians presence in the road.

Lastly, thank you to parents who encourage children to walk their bikes and scooters over the crossing site. Please encourage children to dismount as this is for the safety of the patrols and other pedestrians. Also it is good practise for when children will make unaccompanied journeys in the future, as by dismounting they will be able to give their full attention to approaching traffic.
