



Brontë H performed her final ice show of Beauty and the Beast!





Our runners acquitted themselves fantastically at the County Cross-Country Championships at Garons Park, Southend on Wednesday, winning our first-ever medals at this level.






The Cathedral School's first-ever medals at County Cross-Country Championship





Chelmsford Cathedral Girls' Choir: places available

There are 3 spaces available for girl choristers starting September 2023 (or sooner, if they're keen!). Ideally, we are looking for girls who are currently in school year 5 or 6, so that they'd be starting in year 6 or 7 in September.

Auditions are very simple and not too stressful (we hope!), and the main thing we look for is enthusiasm for singing, as well as potential. We do not expect significant previous choral or even formal musical experience at year 6 or 7, but of course this is always welcome and beneficial. The choir is free to join, and includes some amazing musical experiences such as tours, recordings, radio/TV broadcasts, and concerts – we recently visited Canterbury Cathedral to sing there (listen to us singing with their choir here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6ML8BL-VOJU) Rehearsals currently take place before and after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
