

## When you're feeling overwhelmed...

Often we can find ourselves feeling life is all a bit much. Sudden feelings of not being able to think clearly, not knowing how we'll be able to fit everything in to our day or feeling anxious at the prospect of a hard challenge. These emotions can leave adults feeling overwhelmed let alone children. Show children how to calm themselves and model this as an adult.

#### Try these techniques:

Place your hand on your child's spine to help them realise you are present and supporting their needs. Alternatively, gently squeeze their thigh with your hand to let them know they are secure and safe. Sometimes, words aren't necessary but actions can convey more meaning.


