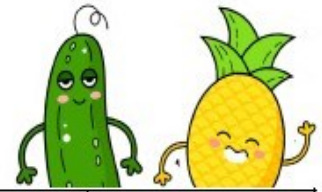

Good Beginnings Course

Do you have a child in EYFS or younger with social communication needs or autism? Would you like to learn more about how to support your child, and meet other parent/carers?

Good Beginnings is a 10 week course for parent/carers delivered by Essex County Council and is taking place across the county at a variety of times and locations. It is a face to face course for parents and carers of children aged 5 or under, who have autism or social communication needs although a diagnosis of autism is not needed to access Good Beginnings.

The course covers:

- understanding autism
- communication
- play
- sensory processing
- behaviour is communication
- eating, sleeping and toileting
- managing anxiety

Autism Central Peer Education Programme - East of England Hub

The Autism Central Peer Education Programme offers families and carers of autistic people high-quality and easily accessible autism education, information and support. Essex County Council, in collaboration with Essex Family Forum, hold the contract to deliver the programme across the Eastern region.

How it can help

Sometimes, talking to people who share similar experiences to yours means you're more likely to feel understood and get the help you need. The programme is a free, all age service. You do not need a diagnosis to access the support. The programme offers support in three ways:

- The Autism Central website which has an ever-growing range of information and guidance on a broad range of autism related topics
- Weekly, online group sessions for parents - anything autism related can be discussed
- 1:1 support for parents/carers via a telephone or Teams call

The programme is run by families for families. Each session is facilitated by Peer Educators who are themselves parents and carers of autistic people. They listen, offer guidance and signpost to services available in the local area.
